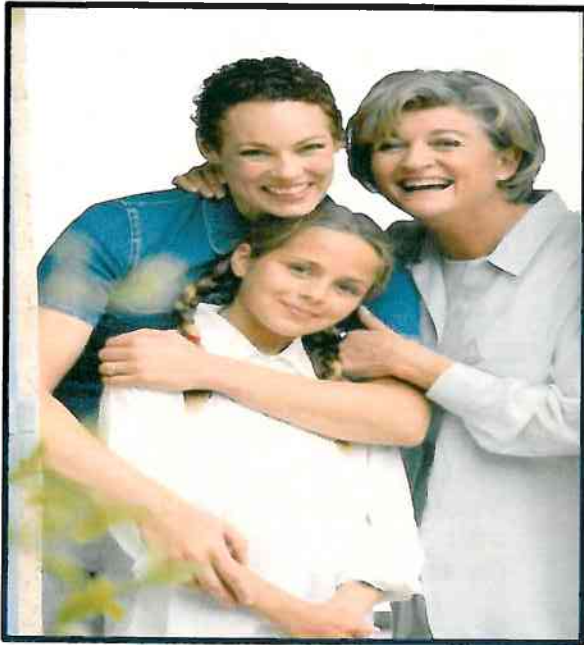

## Rocky Mountain PACE Philosophy

Rocky Mountain PACE (Program of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly) is committed to the belief that seniors with chronic care needs and their families are best served in the community whenever possible.

Rocky Mountain PACE services Colorado Springs residents aged 55 or older who are certified by the state of Colorado to need nursing home care but are able to live safely in the community at the time of enrollment. Our goal is to help our participants achieve their highest level of independence by utilizing a coordinated team approach to health care. Only about 14 percent of PACE participants reside in nursing homes. If an enrollee does need nursing home care, Rocky Mountain PACE pays for it and continues to coordinate the enrollee's care.

There are no hidden costs or co-payments for any Rocky Mountain PACE services. Once a person enrolls in Rocky Mountain PACE, all services are provided through Rocky Mountain PACE. The participant or family must pay for any resources used from outside the service system. For participants who are eligible for Medicare, Rocky Mountain PACE will provide all Medicare covered services.

## ROCKY MOUNTAIN Program of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly

Rocky Mountain PACE delivers all needed medical and supportive services. We provide the entire continuum of care to seniors with chronic care needs while maintaining their independence in their homes for as long as possible.

Care and services include:

- Adult day care offering nursing; physical, occupational and recreational therapies; meals and nutritional counseling; social work and personal care.
- Medical care provided by a Rocky Mountain PACE physician familiar with the history, needs and preferences of each participant
- Home health care and personal care
- All prescription drugs
- Social work services
- "Through-Door" transportation services
- Medical specialists such as audiologists, dentists, optometrists, podiatrists and speech therapists
- Respite care
- Hospital and nursing home care when necessary
